

FAQs

1. I will be attending the TSDP 2016 pujo with my spouse and my son/daughter who is 6 years old. Can I register as a 'Family'?
 - a. Yes, you can register as a family as long as your kid/s is/are less than 25 years of age.

2. I will be attending the pujo with my spouse and son/daughter and son-in-law/daughter-in-law who are around 30 years old. Can we register as a 'Family'?
 - a. No, Your son/daughter and son-in-law/daughter-in-law needs to register separately. In this case it will be two family registrations since our cut-off age for kids attending pujo with parents is 25.

3. My 21 year old son is in college and my 28 year old son is working- they will attend pujo with their girlfriends. May I include them in my family registration?
 - a. Young adults in the family upto 25 can be included. Young adults 26 and over, as well as spouses/friends- all need to register separately.

4. I have parents visiting me in the US and my parents will be coming to the TSDP 2016. How much are the registration fees for visiting parents?
 - a. Attendance of visiting parents is complimentary with family registration or sponsorships only.

5. I did not get any paper forms to register for 2016 Durga puja. Can we get a paper form?
 - a. We are going green this year for our registration. The entire registration process is being done online. We request you to click the registration link on our website baiweb.org to complete the registration process. For any assistance with registration, you are welcome to email us at support@baiweb.org or call (779) 770-6325; Hours: 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM and 5:00 PM to 9:00 PM ET.

6. I have/will be registering soon for 2016 Durga puja. By which date should we send the check to avail the Early bird discount?
 - a. The checks should be sent (postmarked) to our address (3961 Rowlett Pl, Carmel, IN) by Sep 9th 2016 to avail the early bird discount.

7. I will not be able to register by Sep 9th and will miss the early bird registration. What will be the registration rates for my family and me?
 - a. The rates for regular registration (September 10 - September 30) are \$200 per family or \$85 per single attendee.

The rates for late or on-site registration (October 1 – October 8-9) are \$225 per family or \$100 per single attendee.

The full registration rates information along with the deadlines are mentioned on our TSDP 2016 webpage under registration.

8. I can only stay for one day- what is your one day rate?
 - a. There is no one-day rate. Because fixed costs are very high, everyone has to pay the same rate.

9. My non Bengali friends would like to come to observe Puja- they don't want to stay for lunch or dinner- do they still have to pay registration fee?
 - a. Puja and prashad are free but if they want any meals they will have to register

10. My parents, sister and her family are visiting. May I include them in our family registration?
 - a. Visiting parents are free but adult extended family members will need to register separately.

11. I do not want to take part in Puja or any of the meals but would like to attend the cultural program, do I have to register?
 - a. Yes, you have to register for any meals and/or cultural program.

12. I am not receiving any email updates for Durga pujo. How do I register?
 - a. Please visit the registration page and click on the link "Don't have account with us? Please Register". Once you register for puja, your email will be automatically added to the TSDP 2016 email mailing list.

13. I received the registration email but cannot locate it? How do I get a new password/register?
 - a. If you have received registration email and cannot remember your password please reset password. If you cannot remember if you have received registration email, please reattempt to register.
